RE: ADMISSION INTO ORDINARY DIPLOMA IN PHARMACEUTICAL SCIENCES

I am pleased to inform you that your application has been successfully. You have been selected to join Ordinary Diploma in Clinical Medicine at Mlimba Institute of health and allied sciences (Mihas). Congratulations for being selected and thank you for choosing Mihas. The academic year will commence on 2nd October, 2023.

You are required to report to the college on 02^{nd} October 2023 for registration.

Note that there will be two weeks for orientation before starting of classes on 16^{th} October 2023. You should ensure that you register with the college admission office within two weeks from the beginning of the semester. Failure to do so your vacancy will be given to the other applicant.

The registration process shall not be complete without paying required tuition fees and other charges. Therefore make sure you pay the required fees and charges in accordance with the schedule attached with this letter.

You are advised to pay the fee through College bank accounts and come with bank pay slip during arrival to avoid money loss.

NOTE: Registration period will commence on 2nd October 2023 to 15th October 2023. Any late student will not be accepted.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

1. LOCATION AND TRANSPORT TO MIHAS

Mlimba Institute of Health and allied Sciences (MIHAS) is located at Mlimba ward, Kilombero District in Morogoro Region which is about 6 kilometres from Mlimba railway station (TAZARA).

In order to arrive at MIHAS from anywhere in Tanzania, you will have to board a public transport to Makambako railway station or Dare salaam Railway station then take a train transport to Mlimba Railway Station or Any where you will be board a transport to Ifakara-Morogoro then from ifakara take a transport to MLIMBA. OR at any point where you will be ask the help from the college contacts so that you can get help.

You are advised to communicate with college in any step of transport for further help.

2. ARRIVAL

You should arrive at MIHAS on **02**nd **October, 2023**. Please make your own travel arrangements to enable you travel to MIHAS. You will have to meet all travel expenses on your own and there is no refund/reimbursement.

The Institute does not provide students with bed linen. You are therefore advised to bring the following items for you:-

4. UNIFORMS

MALES:

- i. Two Khaki Tetron / Cotton Trousers. Students are not allowed to tailor tight trousers.
- ii. Two white Shirts with short sleeves
- iii. Black/ Dark Brown Shoes.
- iv. One white Clinical Coats. Should be long with long sleeves.

FEMALES:

- I. Two heavy Tetron / Cotton White Dresses with short sleeved. Make sure your dresses are 2 inches below the knees.
- II. Dresses design should resemble the Nurses uniforms.
- III. One white Clinical Coat. should be long with long sleeves.

NOTE:

- > Jeans materials are not allowed in classes and during clinical/practical duties in hospitals.
- Uniforms are tailed at the college for those who need that service by total amount of Tsh. 150,000/ paid by cash and not at bank -except shoes.

- ii. Copy of O- Level Certificate and or Valid result slips (mandatory)
- iii. Three passport-size photos of the student.
- iv. Bank Slips (mandatory).

4 Installments (AWAMU 4) AND OTHER PAYMENT INSTRUCTIONS.

First installment should be paid during reporting to the first semester, second installment should be paid in December 2023, third installment during reporting to the second semester and last installment in June 2024.

All payments should be made through Account No. CRDB NO. 0150431072400 with the name MLIMBA INSTITUTE OF HEALTH AND ALIED SCIENCE & NMB 24410002185 with the name MLIMBA INSTITUTE OF HEALTH AND ALIED SCIENCE

- ❖ NACTE Examination fee TZS 150,000/= will be paid directly to Ministry of Health through control number on second semester after instructions from college management.
- ❖ NHIF Fee TZS 50,400/= for those who don't have cards yet, will be paid by cash during reporting date.
- Meals fee is TZS 1,000,000/= (optional) which will be paid in four (4) installments (TZS 250,000/= each) via college bank account numbers. Chicken meat and fruits will be saved once per week.
- For hostels chances, students who will be registered earlier will be given priority.
- ❖ Internal supplementary/special examination fee is TSH 30,000/= per module. For Nacte Exams supplementary fee is TSH 100,000/= for all academic services.
- For students who will fail more than half of their subjects (repeat module) will pay 75% of semester total fee.
- Community and field & research Cost (meals, accommodation and transports) for secondand third-year students will be covered by students themselves.

- (i) Fees once paid will not be refunded if a student withdraws or leaves the College.
- (ii) Payment by cheque, International Money Orders (IMO) etc is accepted prior to clearance by the bank.
- (iii) Payment by M-Pesa, TigoPesa, and Airtel Money is strictly not accepted.
- (iv) Fees must be paid through the college bank account and not otherwise
